- do the laundry /'ləʊndri/
- do the shopping
- do the vacuuming /'vækjuːmɪŋ/

- load the dishwasher (opposite unload)
- make lunch (or dinner)
- make the bed
- pick up dirty clothes (from the floor)
- put away your clothes
- set the table (opposite clear)
- take out the garbage /'gɑːbɪdʒ/

- When I come, our home are cleaned, how can she do alone?
- When you want to talk about sth started in past and finish recently, you use **present perfect**.



(+) she **has** cleaned our room.

(+) she's cleaned our room.

(+) I **have** cooked dinner.

(+) I've cooked dinner.

(-) she **hasn't** gone to work.

(-) I **haven't** bought groceries.



Verb: {
→ Regular verb → +ed / d
→ Irregular verb → change verb: go → gone
buy → bought

Yes, she has / No, she hasn't
