Bored– boring

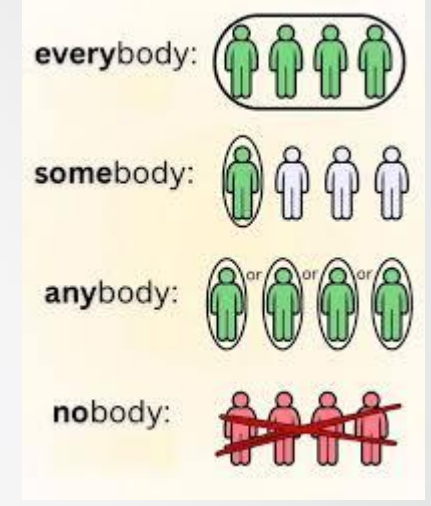
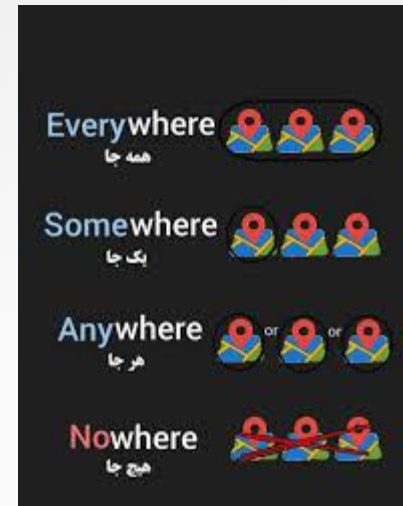
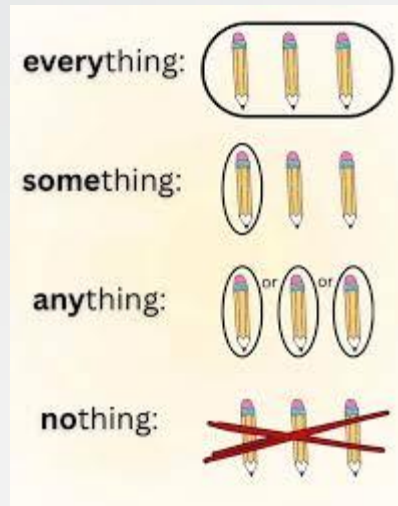
Surprised– surprising

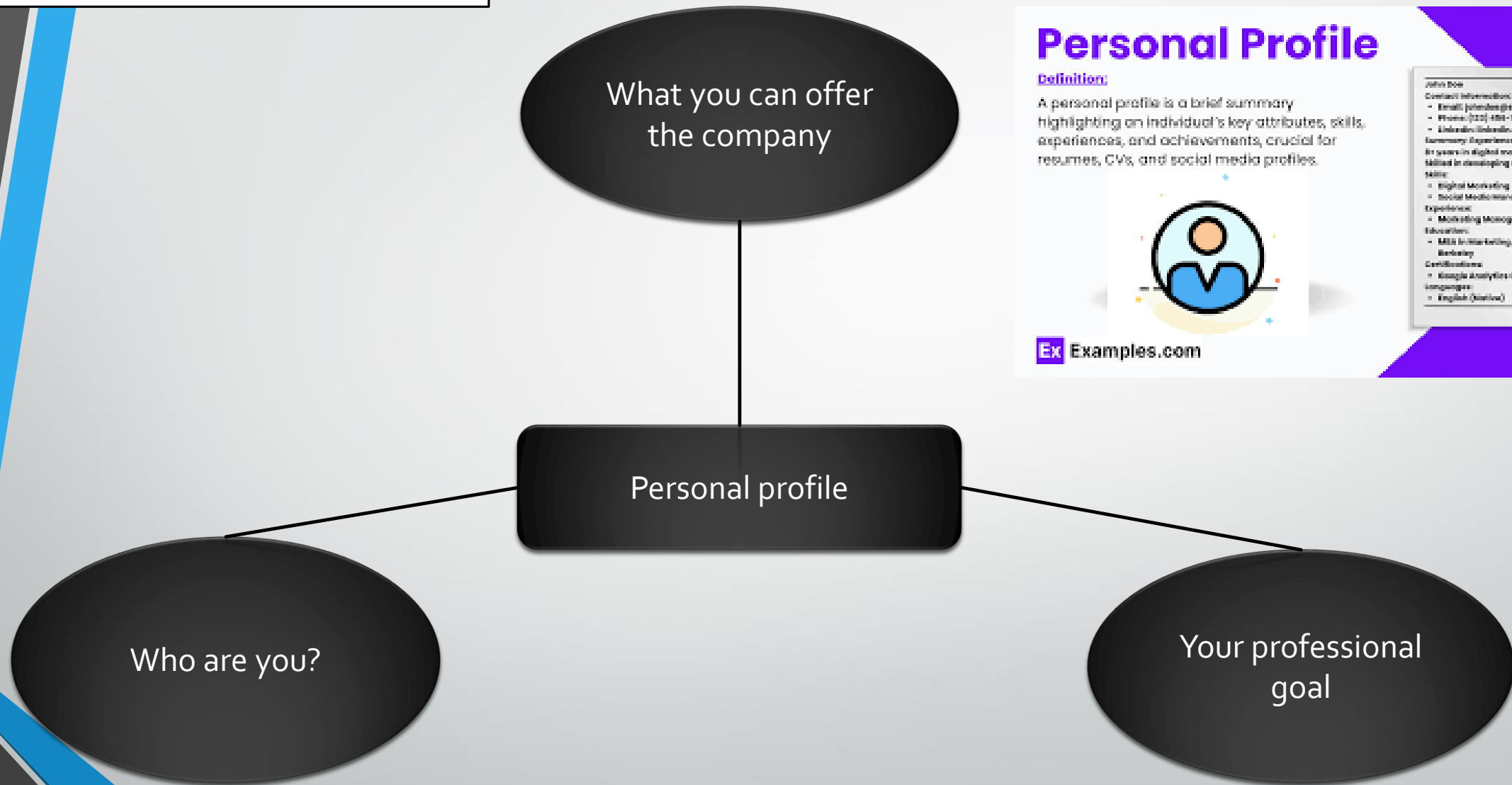
